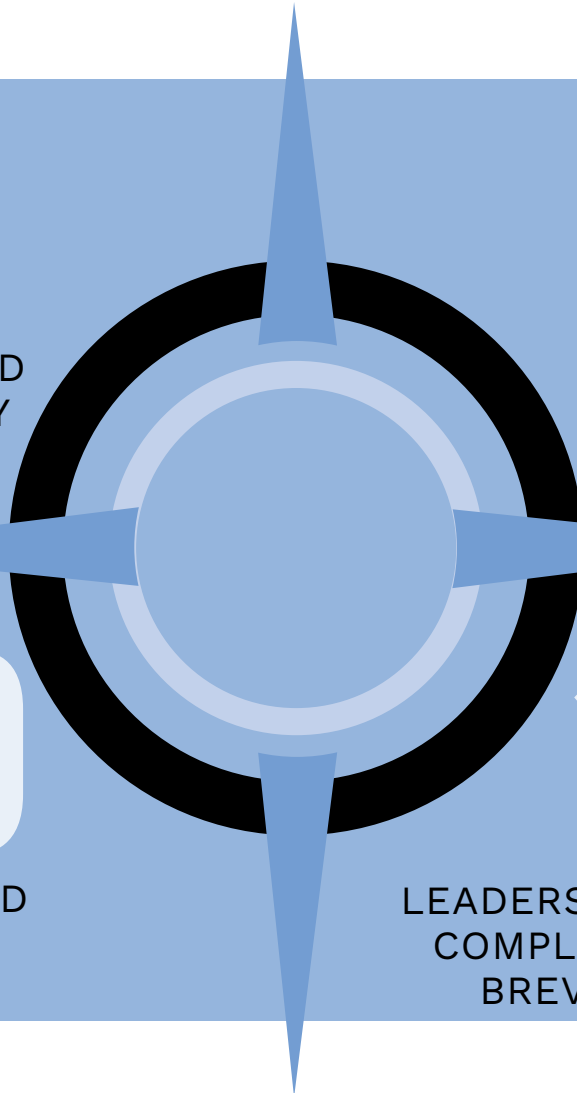

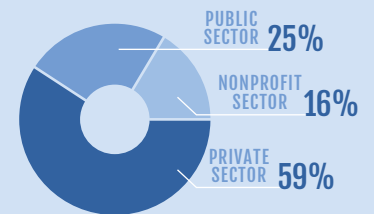
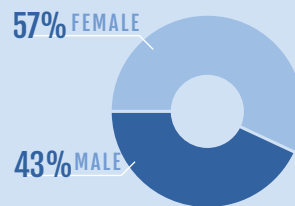

- Leadership Styles – The 360 Degree Leader

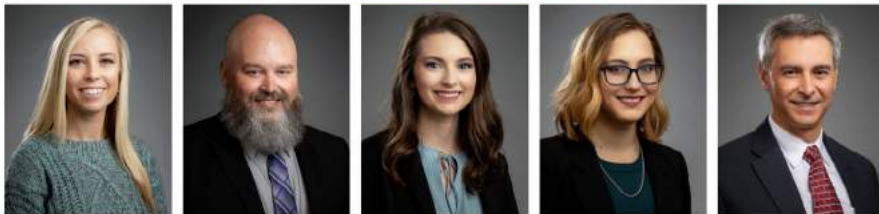
