As I conclude my term as board chairman, I take satisfaction in knowing LEAD Brevard remains the preeminent leadership organization serving Florida's Space Coast. We are financially strong, our Board of Directors are engaged, and our programs and events are popular and well-attended.

However, we, like many other community-based organizations (CBOs), face challenges in our future as funding for organizations like ours get cut from county and state budgets due to mounting pressure to address other civic needs. In April 2017 the Brevard County Commission reduced funding for all CBOs, including those providing vital programs that assist many of our neighbors in need, such as feeding and protecting the homeless, children, and seniors. I am proud that our board stood up as leaders and agreed to renounce our \$40,000 in annual county funding in order to mitigate the cuts to other organizations in order that they may continue their efforts to serve.

This cut in government funding means that LEAD Brevard is increasing our efforts to sustain itself independently to support our operations, and our board and staff stepped up with strategies and new programs to fill that revenue gap and maintain organizational sustainability as we go forward.

As I turn the board reins over to my chair-elect, Dale Ketcham, I know with confidence that LEAD Brevard is in capable hands. Dale has been affiliated with LEAD Brevard since its beginning, as a member of the very first class of Leadership Brevard in 1986. I look forward to continuing to work with Dale, the board, our amazing staff, our members, our alumni and the rest of the community in my new role as immediate past chair.

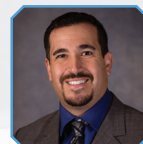

Leadership Action Project Summaries

A 'leadership laboratory', Leadership Action Projects are a key component of each Leadership Brevard class.

In 2018, seven projects were selected through a Request for Proposal (RFP) process; over 2600 volunteer hours at \$24.69* equals **\$64,194.00 of economic impact** to our community and solutions to challenges faced by our nonprofit sector.

Aging Matters in Brevard

"PETS ON WHEELS"

A collaborative project with the Central Brevard Humane Society... to provide pet food to homebound Meals on Wheels clients and participants in the Seniors At Lunch congregate dining program. The project created a process for identifying participants and the type of food needed, organizing volunteers and tracking with an ultimate goal of making this a volunteer-run program in future years.

Brevard Achievement Center (BAC)

"PLANNING FOR THE FUTURE CARE OF ADULTS WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES"

BAC is aware that not all of their clients' parents (as primary care giver for the 150 adults with disabilities served by BAC) have end-of-life plans in place to ensure the on-going health, safety and wellness of their adult child with disabilities. This LAP team created a survey instrument to assess current end of life planning, following HIPAA requirements and a specific action plan to present to BAC board with tactics to aid greater numbers of families in overcoming barriers to create end of life plans.

Brevard Homeless Coalition, Inc.

"AFFORDABLE HOUSING IN BREVARD COUNTY"

The project analyzed and assessed the present situation in Brevard County and proposes both short and long term strategies to improve. The project team members interacted with organizations and individuals in the community who are aware of the challenges and committed to meeting them. Recommendations are taking the form of policy changes, collaborative investments and communication efforts. The deliverable is a report and presentation presenting findings and suggesting next steps.

The Children's Hunger Project

"FEED 500 CAMPAIGN VIDEO"

A 2 minute video highlighting the need in Brevard County to help feed children who are going hungry on the weekends has been written, shot, edited and produced by this team. The video will be used by the organization to enhance community presentations and is intended for use on the agency website and social media. Currently, the Children's Hunger Project is distributing packages of food to 1500 children at 36 elementary schools; their research shows that the need in our county is over 3000 children.

Guardian Ad Litem (GAL), 18th Circuit

"ENCOURAGING VOLUNTEERS TO TAKE LEADERSHIP ROLES"

Currently, 300 children appointed to GAL are without trained volunteers to assist them; this program is committed to providing leadership roles for their volunteers. The LAP team's short term goal was to identify barriers for Volunteer Team Leader recruitment; a mid-range goal to increase the number of trained Volunteer Team Leaders, recruit and retain 25 new leaders by mid-2018 and a long term goal to empower volunteer team leaders to help recruit new volunteers and help in the retention of current volunteers.

Junior League of South Brevard, Inc.

"GIRL POWER"

Girl POWER will consist of free workshops conducted throughout the year once the project is launched (self-esteem, nutrition, leadership and mentoring for young women ages 16-21). This LAP planned the introductory symposium held in April 2018, including sessions on personal finance, self-esteem and body image, preparation for the job market and personal safety (including internet).

LEAD Brevard, Inc. with The Board Doctor, LLC

"LEADERSHIP IMPACT: MATCHING LEADERSHIP BREVARD ALUMNI WITH NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS NEEDING SKILLED BOARD MEMBERS"

A system to match nonprofit organizations in Brevard County (over 1,695 with 501 c 3 status) with Leadership Brevard Alumni and others who are ready and willing to serve on a board of directors is underway and the team has presented proof of concept. Project elements have included gathering information from nonprofits about their board needs, gathering information from alumni about their interests and skills, testing several initial matches, building a type of interactive web based 'data base' or means of ongoing match services and creating a plan for long term sustainability, which will include identifying a revenue stream for long term support.

LEAD Brevard's alumni member based programming, including capacity building for organizations via our annual board governance workshop, strives to address the multiple interests of LEAD Brevard members ranging from networking and social time to professional development opportunities. Financial Highlights YE 2018

In April 2017 the Brevard County Commission reduced funding for many community organizations, including those providing vital programs that assist our neighbors in need, such as feeding and protecting the homeless, children, and seniors. The LEAD Brevard Board of Directors unanimously adopted a position to renounce \$40,000 in annual county funding in order to mitigate the cuts to other organizations in order that they may continue their efforts to serve. Subsequently, YE 2018 saw a 50% reduction in those funds awarded previously to LEAD Brevard and YE 2019 will be a 100% reduction.

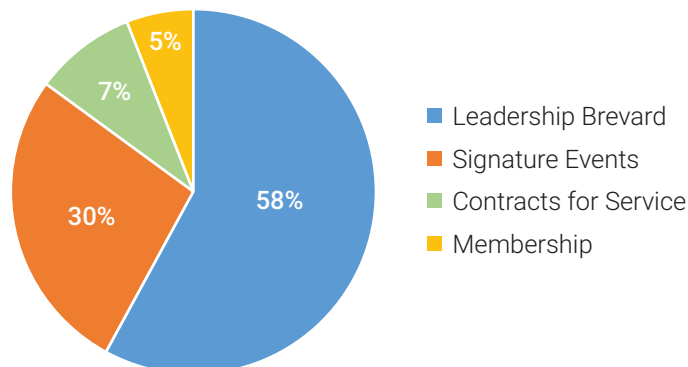

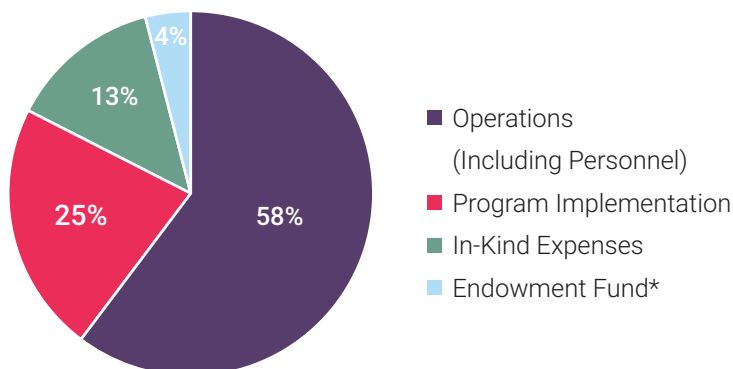
